





Air pollution and its impact in Europe

Europe's air quality is slowly improving, but fine particulate matter, nitrogen dioxide and ozone continue to cause serious impacts on health.

More than **400,000 premature deaths** in EU-28 each year.

Heart disease and stroke are the most common reasons for premature death attributable to air pollution, followed by lung diseases and lung cancer




QC2 Do you think that, over the last 10 years, the air quality in (OUR COUNTR has ? (% - EU)







WHO NCDs Target 1 Mortality to be reduced by 25% in 2025 Death rates (per 100,000)









Figure 1.13: Population living in a dwelling with a leaking roof, damp walls, floors or foundation Figure 1.14: Population living in a dwelling with a leaking roof, damp walls, floors or foundation or rot in window frames or floor, by country, 2012 and 2017 (% of population)







QC1 How informed do you feel about air quality problems in (OUR COUNTRY)? (% - EU)








Majority of Europeans have not heard of EU Air Quality standards




