## APPENDIX C. BACKGROUND DEMOGRAPHIC AND HOSPITAL INFORMATION

The population in the 5 -county Atlanta metropolitan area grew from 2.85 million people in 1999 to 3.54 million in 2013, a $24.2 \%$ increase (Figure C.1). The current $\mathrm{PM}_{2.5}$ 20-county Atlanta nonattainment area (ANAA) grew from 4.01 million people in 1999 to 5.35 million in 2013 (a 33.5\% increase), while the entire state of Georgia increased in population $24.2 \%$ during this time, from 8.05 to 9.99 million. The Atlanta metropolitan area is racially diverse, in the 5county area in 2000, $50.8 \%$ of the population were non-Hispanic white, $35.3 \%$ were nonHispanic black, $7.9 \%$ were Hispanic/Latino, $4.2 \%$ were non-Hispanic Asian, and $1.8 \%$ were other race (Table C.1). This diversity increased by 2010: 40.3\% of the population were nonHispanic white, $38.4 \%$ were non-Hispanic black, $12.5 \%$ were Hispanic/Latino, $6.4 \%$ were nonHispanic Asian, and 2.4\% were other race.

Between 2000 and 2010, the proportion of the population in older groups increased in the 5-county area. The proportion of the population who were 45-64 year old males grew from 9.8\% to $11.7 \%$, the proportion of the population who were 65 and older males grew from $2.8 \%$ to $3.4 \%$, the proportion of the population who were $45-64$ year old females grew from $10.6 \%$ to $13.0 \%$, and the proportion of the population who were 65 and older females grew from $4.4 \%$ to $4.8 \%$. The per capita income (adjusted for inflation to December 2013 dollars) decreased from
\$35,139 to \$30,068 from 1999-2013, while the percent unemployed rose from $4.0 \%$ to $7.0 \%$ and the percent of families under the federal poverty level rose from $7.6 \%$ to $12.7 \%$. However, the educational attainment of the 5-county population rose as well, with the proportion of the population having high school education level or higher increasing from $85.6 \%$ to $88.9 \%$ from 1999-2013, and the proportion of the population having a bachelor's degree or higher increasing from $36.5 \%$ to $40.1 \%$ from 1999-2013.
